This survey is given annually so we are able to compare the results each year to see where we have improved and what we need to continue to work on. Students and teachers complete the survey as well. Students will complete the survey in school over the next few weeks.

Beginning February 12, teachers and students in grades 4-12 across the archdiocese will have an opportunity to participate in our annual Climate, Culture and Catholic Identity Survey utilizing the University of Chicago Impact 5Essentials Survey (5Essentials) plus a customized, Catholic Identity survey. We also invite all parents to participate by sharing your thoughts on the important elements of school effectiveness in the UChicago Impact's Parent Survey. The surveys will be administered online by UChicago Impact.

This survey is designed to generate a detailed picture of the inner workings of your child's school. The reason we conduct the survey each year is because 5Essentials gathers data related to five indicators that can predict important student outcomes, including improved attendance and larger test score gains. Prior research has shown that schools strong on at least three of these "5Essential" indicators were 10 times more likely to improve student learning gains in math and reading. In fact, we value the data this survey provides our school leaders with so much that one of our system-wide goals for each school is based on the survey.

The five indicators that affect and predict school success are:

- Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Involved Families
- Supportive Environments
- Ambitious Instruction
