## St. Elizabeth of the Trinity Athletic Code of Conduct

Athletics is an integral part of the school's total educational program. All school activities, curricular and extra-curricular, in the classroom and on the playing field, must be congruent with the school's mission of Wisdom, Worship and Works. It is within this context that the following Code of Ethics is presented in the framework of the St. Elizabeth of the Trinity Virtues for both student athletes and their families:

As an Athlete, I understand that it is my RESPONSIBILITY to:

- 1. Maintain grades above a C- (see extracurricular eligibility policy)
- 2. Attend practices and games
- 3. Bring the proper equipment with me to practices and games
- 4. Clean up after games and practices, at any gym I am in

As a parent I understand that it is my responsibility to:

- 1. Ensure my student has a way to and from practice and games.
- 2. Communicate with coaches if my child will not be at a practice or a game with as much notice as is reasonably possible.
- 3. Supporting any academic interventions that teachers put in place to help my student maintain their grades.

As an Athlete, I understand that I will be RESPECTFUL by:

- 1. Being kind to my teammates and coaches
- 2. Accepting the calls of the referees in the games
- 3. Showing good sportsmanship to the other team members

As a parent I understand that I will be respectful by:

- 1. Accepting the calls of the referees and coaches in games
- 2. Modeling sportsmanship and respect in my own interactions with their coaches, referees, teammates, and their families.

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As an Athlete, I will display my FAITH in God by:

- 1. Attending the Team mass scheduled
- 2. Praying before the game with my teammates, opposing players and spectators
- 3. Win with character, lose with dignity

As a parent I will support my child's faith by:

- 1. Bringing my child to Team Mass and attending with them if I am able.
- 2. Praying before games with the athletes
- 3. Supporting my child and modeling for them what it means to win with character, lose with dignity.

If these virtues are not followed, I/ my child could be ineligible to play or be removed from the team.
