Battle of the Books is back! Battle of the Books is a program for students in grades 3-8 in which students are divided into teams and given a list of books to read and then "Battle" against other teams. During the Battle, teams collaborate to answer questions, both oral and written, about the books. The team with the highest score wins that Battle. Many battles take place over the season, and at the end of the season, one team will be our school champion team. Finally, a small group of students are selected based on their participation, attendance, and books read to represent the school as our traveling team in a battle among area schools.

We will be meeting on Thursdays after school from 3:05-3:45 in the auditorium. If your student is interested in being a part of Battle of the Books, please sign the permission slip below and return to school by October 20th. Each grade will have their own list of books to read and these will be given to the students at their first meeting. The first meeting will be on November 6th, 2025.
